Transit Visa Application

Who should use this form?

You must send the passport (the original document) of each person included in the application with your completed and signed form. You must also provide two passport-size photographs of each person, evidence of your travel arrangements, and a statement of the purpose of your visit to your destination country.

We will process your application only when we receive all the information and documents we need. If you do not send all the required information, we will return your application.

Group transit visas

If you are a Chinese national and you will be transiting New Zealand with a group of Chinese nationals, you may apply for a group transit visa. As well as completing this form and providing the information listed above, your tour organiser or agent will need to complete the form *Group Transit Application (INZ 1155)* on behalf of the group.
